

COOKIE MANAGEMENT CHARTER



PREAMBLE

This Cookie Management Charter is intended for users of the website <https://yris.ozyme.fr> (hereinafter the "Platform"), i.e. any person accessing and browsing the Platform, and in particular Users registered on the Platform or visiting Internet users.

You can find out more about the nature of the cookies deposited, accept or refuse them either globally for the entire site and all services, or service by service.

By accessing the Platform, you are invited to consent to the deposit of cookies as described below. You may consent to the deposit of all cookies or only some of them. However, you may revoke your consent and refuse to accept cookies or change your cookie preferences at any time.

SECTION 1. WHO COLLECTS MY DATA?

OZYME, a French joint-stock company with a capital of 168,210 euros, registered in the Versailles trade and companies register under no. 331 046 847, whose registered office is located at 6, boulevard Georges Marie Guynemer, Zac de la Caserne Charles Renard Bâtiment G, 78210 Saint Cyr L'Ecole, France, publishes and operates the internet platform accessible at <https://yris.ozyme.fr> (hereinafter "OZYME" or "We").

SECTION 2. WHAT IS A COOKIE?

A cookie is a small text file deposited on the hard disk of your terminal when you visit a website. It records certain information about your browsing or online behavior that enables us to improve and facilitate your experience as a web user.

SECTION 3. WHY ARE COOKIES USED?

The cookies used on the Platform are used to differentiate you in order to improve your browsing and the services we provide to you.

In practice, technical cookies enable us to authenticate you, identify you, speed up your browsing on our site and access to its various features. Where applicable, they may record your preferences or measure the different uses of the Platform.

Other audience measurement cookies and tracers may be used to establish statistics on the audience of our site, in order to improve and offer you ever-greater comfort in visiting our site, and to provide you with advertising and promotional offers targeted according to your browsing.

SECTION 4. WEBSITE COOKIES AND THEIR PURPOSE

OZYME favors transparency in the processing of your data. To this end, and to ensure that your information is as clear as possible, you will find below various cookies used on the Platform and their purpose:

4.1 First-party cookies

- 4.1.1 **Functional and technical cookies** mainly allow you to improve your browsing on the Platform. They are the ones that will send information to our Platform and to your browser: storage of information relating to a form (identifier, address), your terminal's display preferences (languages, resolution), security measures such as the expiry of the session, etc.

- 4.1.2 **Technical cookies for statistics and audience measurement** of the Platform help us to better understand the use made of the Platform and to offer you quality services:

Nom du cookie	Purpose of the cookie	Duration
Third Party Cookies (Eloqua basic tracking)	This cookie enables to track page visits by a contact, but it does not require agreeing to accept cookies. It is stored on the contact's browser. However, this type of cookies has an increased chance of being block natively by browsers or by plug-ins such as Ad Block.	Unlimited as long as the contact does not delete the cookies from its browser
First Party Cookies	This cookie enables to track visits to a page by a contact, this one requires an acceptance of cookies via a pop-in/banner. This one is stored on the contact's browser. This type of cookie is much better accepted by browsers unlike the third party; however, the risk 0 of blocking does not exist.	Unlimited as long as the contact does not delete the cookies from its browser

4.2 Third-party cookies

When you visit the Platform, partner companies may place cookies on your terminal.

The use of these cookies is subject to the same restrictions on the protection of personal data established by the French Data Protection Act ("*loi Informatique et Libertés*"). In the settings of your browser, you can deactivate these third-party cookies alone or at the same time as ours. In particular, there are:

4.2.1 **Cookies related to advertising operations:** These cookies are used by advertising service providers on the Platform.

They enable the identification of consulted or purchased services and promote the personalization of the advertising offer. Cookies contained within advertisements are intended to provide information and statistics on the relevance of their distribution (*number of users clicking on the ad, number of times it is displayed, etc.*).

TechOzyme registration	Enables identification of the persons who registered to TechOzyme	90 days
Paper catalogue request	Enables identification of the persons who have requested a catalogue	90 days

OZYME informs you that it uses the services of Google Analytics to measure the Platform's audience. SECTION 5. INSTALLING THESE COOKIES: IT'S YOUR CHOICE

On your computers, smartphones and other Internet access terminals, by default the browser software accepts cookies present on the websites.

However, you remain in control of the installation of these cookies because you have the possibility to configure your browser software to:

- Accept or refuse cookies on the Platform;
- Systematically refuse all cookies;
- Ask for your consent on each of the cookies you encounter while browsing the Internet.

To do so, simply refer to your browser software and follow its instructions. As an example:

- **With Internet Explorer™** : Tools (in the browser toolbar) ► Internet Options ► Privacy tab ► choose the desired level
- **With Firefox™** : Tools menu (from the top toolbar) ► Options ► Privacy tab ► choose the desired options
- **With Chrome™** : configuration menu (settings logo) ► Settings ► Privacy and security ► Site Settings ► Cookies and site data ► Choose the desired options
- **With Safari™** : Safari menu (settings logo) ► Preferences ► Security ► Show cookies ► Choose the desired options
- **With Opera™** : menu Tools ► Preferences ► Advanced tab ► Cookies section ► Manage cookies ► Choose the desired options

As indicated above, by choosing to block our cookies, we wish to inform you that browsing the Platform and/or the use of certain features could be altered. In any event, if you choose to delete all cookies, your user experience will be strongly affected and your browsing preferences will be erased.

SECTION 6. YOUR CONSENT

By browsing the Platform, you accept that OZYME installs so-called "technical" cookies that access, register and consult information stored in your terminal equipment:

- The sole purpose of these cookies being to enable or facilitate communication by electronic means;
- Strictly necessary for the provision of the Platform's online communication service.

As you accessed the Platform, you were also informed of the presence of tracking cookies intended in particular to provide you with offers adapted to your interests and to produce visit statistics. You must consent to the installation of such cookies. You can change your consent at any time by accessing this Cookie Management Charter.

In any event, you are informed of the purposes for which we collect your data via the various online data collection forms, your customer account or via our [Privacy Policy](#).

If the browser enables it, you can disable these cookies at any time by following the procedure indicated by the browser. However, OZYME informs you that such deactivation may result in slowing down and/or disrupting access to the Platform.

SECTION 7. YOUR RIGHTS OF ACCESS, TO ERASURE, TO OBJECT

In accordance with the French Data Protection Act and the GDPR, you have the following rights:

- Right of access ([Article 15 GDPR](#)), to rectification ([Article 16 GDPR](#)), update, completeness of your data ([more information](#))
- Right to block or of erasure of your personal data ([Article 17 GDPR](#)), that are inaccurate, incomplete, ambiguous, outdated, or whose collection, use, communication or retention is prohibited ([more information](#))
- Right to withdraw your consent at any time ([Article 13-2c GDPR](#))
- Right to restriction of processing of your data ([Article 18 GDPR](#))
- Right to object to processing of your data ([Article 21 GDPR](#)) ([more information](#))
- Right to data portability that you have provided us with, where your data is processed based on your consent or a contract ([Article 20 GDPR](#))
- Right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing (Article 22 GDPR); no such decision is currently applied by OZYME
- Right to define the fate of your data after your death and to choose whether we communicate (or not) to a third party designated by you ([Section 85 of the French Data Protection Act](#)). In case of death and in the absence of instructions from you, we will destroy your data, unless it is necessary to retain it for evidence purposes or to comply with a legal obligation.

SECTION 8. RETENTION PERIOD

In any event, information stored in your terminal (e.g., cookies) or any other element used to identify you for audience statistics purposes is not retained beyond a period of thirteen (13) months. Beyond this period, the raw traffic data associated with an identifier is either deleted or anonymized.
